

## TIPS

- 1. Eierschale Zenner** | Biergarten, restaurant, disco and Burger King all in one, overlooking the Spree | Alt Treptow 14-17
- 2. Insel der Jugend (Youth Island)** | Park with logo, café, restaurant, bar and the firework show "Treptow in Flames" (since 1825) | Alt Treptow 14
- 3. Spreepark** | Falling apart and corroding, the Flying Carpet, the Loop-de-Loop, Canale Grande and Las Vegas County stage a peculiarly tempting scene. Huge unleashed dogs warn against trespassing | Kiehnwerderallee 1-3
- 4. Eierhäuschen** | Built in 1892, the now romantically overgrown Sleeping Beauty was a famous restaurant for day-trippers in its heyday. Princes wanted | On the south-east corner of the Spreepark-area
- 5. Sowjetisches Ehrenmal** | A special place of remembrance for former-GDR citizens – school trips in East Germany were often conducted to this memorial grove | Am Treptower Park und Puschkinallee
- 6. Hallenrödelmarkt Treptow** | Those who want to stay dry during their weekend-long bargain hunting should head to this indoor flea market | Saturdays and Sundays 10 am – 5 pm | Eichenstraße 4
- 7. MS Hoppetosse** | Afternoon coffee or late-night party – the view onto the Oberbaumbrücke is beautiful in any weather | Eichenstraße 4
- 8. Badeschiff** | Topless in the summer, during the winter it's covered - the Badeschiff gets the Berlin scenesters wet. | November to March – sauna, heated pool | May to October – pool, beach | Eichenstraße 4
- 9. Club der Visionäre** | Club and Pizzeria | Dance and party outside by the water while waving to the café clientele across the canal | Am Flutgraben 1
- 10. Freischwimmer** | The more sedate version of canalside romanticism across the way from Club der Visionäre | Restaurant & Wasserlounge | Am schlesischen Graben 2a
- 11. San Remo Upflamör** | Music, café and the raised tracks of the U1 train – pure urban romanticism | Falckensteinstraße 46
